



PATIENT and VISITOR CAR PARK at The Alfred

(Enter via Centre Lane which is off Commercial Road)



Q: What are the hours of operation of the car park?

A: Operating hours are from 6:00am to 10:30pm seven (7) days per week.

Q: Who can park in the car park?

A: The car park is for all patients and visitors to The Alfred precinct.

Q: Where will staff park?

A: Staff parking will be exclusively located in the multilevel car park.

Q: Is there any designated parking for Disabled persons?

A: Yes. There is a car park off Alfred Lane at the rear of the hospital totally allocated for holders of disabled permits. A fee is payable at concession rates. There are a number of free time limited disabled parking spaces within the precinct. A map is available on the Internet.

Q: How will I know which way to go when exiting the car park and making my way to my destination within The Alfred precinct?

A: Clear signage will direct patients and visitors to access any location throughout the campus.

Q: How do I pay for parking in the car park?

A: You can pay for parking in 2 ways:

1. By ticket via automated pay stations opposite the passenger lifts or
2. By payment at a supervised booth on the exit ramp.

Q: How do I enter/exit the car park?

A: Entry. Entry to the car park is via Centre Lane. Centre Lane is located off Commercial Road between The Alfred Centre and the Burnet Institute.

B: Exit. You exit the car park via Centre Lane but please note there is no right turn exit into Commercial Road. Traffic exiting the car park must turn left into Commercial Road. Vehicles can then use the dedicated U-turn zone, which is at the front entrance to The Alfred, if they wish to head east.

Q: Where else can I park when visiting the Alfred?

A: Off street parking, although limited, is available to short term visitors to the hospital on ground level and in certain areas at the front of the Hospital. Please observe the restrictions indicated on the parking signage.

Q: What are the options to car parking available at the Alfred?

A: The Alfred's highly central location means it is easily accessible via train, tram or bus. We strongly recommend using these transport methods to access the hospital. There is also a taxi rank on Commercial Road.
