

Prof Anthony M Dart BA BM BCh FRACP FRCP Dphil



Professor Dart completed an undergraduate degree and PhD in physiology at the University of Oxford. He received training in internal medicine, clinical pharmacology, cardiology and cardiovascular research in Cardiff (UK), Edinburgh (UK) and Heidelberg (Germany). Since arriving in Australia (1988) he has been active in clinical cardiology and cardiovascular research with continuous funding from the NHMRC since that time. His research interests include animal studies in relation to acute myocardial ischaemia, cardiac hypertrophy, cardiac autonomic function and atherosclerosis. Clinical interests have included studies on large artery stiffness, endothelial function and hyperlipidaemia. Professor Dart has been a member (or chair) of numerous committees of the NHMRC and National Heart Foundation. Professor Dart is also medical director for the cardiovascular directorate (business unit) at the Alfred hospital (comprising Cardiovascular Medicine, Cardiothoracic Surgery, Allergy Immunology and Respiratory Medicine and Vascular Surgery). He has published more than 200 peer reviewed articles.
